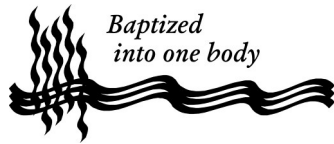


**June 4, 2017**

**"Brothers and sisters 'No one can say 'Jesus is Lord' except by the Holy Spirit. There are different kinds of spiritual gifts but the same Spirit.
